1. **Trade name:**  
**Alpha-Tape®** ABS edge bands
2. **Composition of the product**  
**ABS** | Thermoplastic acrylonitrile – butadiene – styrene - copolymer
3. **Possible hazards**  
None
4. **First aid measures**  
No indication necessary
5. **Fire fighting measures**  
Suitable extinguishing media CO<sup>2</sup>-, powder-, foam-extinguishers, spray water jet, sand.  
Do not use full-blast water jet!  
  
Special hazards When product is burnt, formation of carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide and nitric oxides. Thermal decomposition will result in formation of poisonous vapors.  
  
Special protective equipment or measures for fire-fighting Cool and extinguish the containers exposed to fire with spray water jet. Use self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear complete protective suit.
6. **Measures in case of accidental release**  
Take up mechanically. There are no special safety precautions to be observed.
7. **Storage and handling**
  - 7.1 Storage Store product under dry conditions. Keep product stored away from inflammable substances.
  - 7.2 Handling Remove vapors of the product emitted during thermal processing by vacuum suction directly at their source.
8. **Exposure – limitation and personal protective equipment**  
Beyond the general rules of industrial hygiene there are no further special safety precautions to be observed. Also see item 7.
9. **Toxicological information**  
When items 7. and 8. are observed: no further details.
10. **Ecological information**  
According to the Commission for Water-Polluting Substances, plastics are generally not to be considered as water-pollutants as long as they are solid, non-dispersible, insoluble and inert / inactive.
11. **Disposal considerations**
